## MANAGEMENT OF SCALP PSORIASIS THROUGH AYURVEDA: A CASE REPORT

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#### **ABSTRACT**

Kitibha of Ayurvedic literature is compared and accepted with Psoriasis. It pacifies Vata and Kapha Dosha. Scalp Psoriasis is a widespread condition of the skin, which causes elevated, reddish, sometimes skinny spots. It may occur as one or several patches and even affect the whole scalp. **Objective:** To see the effect of *Avurvedic* drugs and local applications can help in Kitibha kushtha. Methodology: In this case, a 20-year male patient had been experiencing symptoms of Reddish-white patches over-head, scaling of skin, Itching all over body. Ayurvedic medicines were used in the study for two months. **Discussion:** The major goal of the treatment is to help to eliminate scales. The medicines were used in the study also purify the impure blood. Ashtmurti Rasayana, Gandhaka Rasayan both are blood purifier also work as broad-spectrum antibiotics Ashtmurti Rasayana has Jantughna property. Panch Nimba Churna is purifying in nature. Rasa Manikya has antimicrobial property and balances Vata-Kapha dosha. It removes Ama (toxins) accumulated under the skin. Godanti helps in Pitta balance and anti-inflammatory property. Conclusion: Each science has its own fundamentals of the management and success rate with its own limitations. But still now an effective and promising cure for Psoriasis is not found. So, there is need of era to develop some Ayurveda treatment modalities for Psoriasis. Keeping the fundamentals of management in mind the current study was conducted which will be helpful for curing the *Kitibha Kushtha* (Psoriasis).

## **INTRODUCTION**

Psoriasis is a chronic inflammatory skin disease with a strong genetic predisposition and autoimmune pathogenic traits. Psoriasis is one such disease in which skin cells multiply ten times faster than normal. Nowadays the percentage of people suffering from Auto Immune diseases is increasing day by day. The clinical presentation varies from mild to severe and typically presents with asymmetric, sharply demarcated, silvery white erythematous scaly plagues. Though the exact cause for these diseases is unknown Many attribute it to bacteria or fungus that cause immune system alterations, stress genes and the common cold are the triggers. Psoriasis is one such disease in which skin cells multiply ten times faster

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than normal. Patients with scalp psoriasis may also suffer from severe emotional effects.

Scalp comprises the forehead and the hairbearing regions. It extends from the supraorbital ridge anteriorly to the highest nuchal line posteriorly. Skin, subcutaneous connective tissue, galea, subaponeurotic loose areolar tissue, and pericranium are the five layers that make up the scalp.

The scalp is one of the most commonly affected region in psoriasis. However, due of difficulties with the administration of medication, scalp psoriasis can be challenging to cure. Patient's quality of life must be improved with effective treatment plans for scalp psoriasis.

In modern science and Ayurveda a lot of research work has been done on etiogenesis, pathophysiology and treatment of Psoriasis. In both sciences lot of work is still going on. Each science has its own fundamentals of the management and success rate with its own limitations. But still now an effective and promising cure for Psoriasis is not found. Allopathic drugs have hazardous side effects. So there

is need of era to develop some Ayurveda treatment modalities for Psoriasis. Keeping the fundamentals of management in mind the current study was conducted which will be helpful for curing the *Kitibha kushtha* (Psoriasis).

**Prevalence:** The worldwide prevalence is about 2%, but varies according to regions<sup>[1]</sup>. Between 45-56 % of psoriasis patients also have scalp psoriasis. However, up to 90% of people with psoriasis can experience


scalp psoriasis during their lifetime. The reported prevalence of psoriasis in countries ranges between 0.09% to 11.43%<sup>[2]</sup>. According to Ayurveda, all skin conditions fall under the umbrella term "*Kushtha*". Although the heading is common for all skin diseases there is further classification and nomenclature of skin diseases as per the *Doshas* as they play a vital role in deciding the line of treatment of the disease.

## Patho-physiology of Psoriasis

of Psoriasis

Trigger (bacterial protein, some other antigen)

Antigen is processed by APCs (Langerhan's cells and dendritic cells)

APCs travel to regional lymph nodes

Interact with activate T-cells

T-cells proliferate, formation of memory T-cells

Enter the circulation

Find their way back to the site of injury and inflammation (ICAM and LAF1)

Encounter the original antigen at the site of injury

Secrete inflammatory cytokines including TNF-α, interferon-gamma, IL-2, IL-6 and IL-8

TNF- $\alpha$  result in proliferation of more T-cells (Production of other inflammatory cytokines)



T-cell migration, Inflammation, More cytokine production

1st Treatment Plan (For 1 month)

Before food

1) Ashthmurti rasayan<sup>[6]</sup> 250 mg + Gandhak Rasayan<sup>[7]</sup> 500mg + Rasa Manikya<sup>[8]</sup> 125 mg + Panchnimba churna<sup>[9]</sup> 1gm + Trivang Bhasma<sup>[10]</sup> 125 mg + Godanti Bhamsa<sup>[11]</sup> 500 mg BD with water.

**After Food:** 2) *Haridra Khanda*[ $^{12}$ ] 1Tsf with *Panchtikta ghrita*[ $^{13}$ ] 10 ml BD

### At Night

*Triphla churna*<sup>[14]</sup> 5gm + *Kutaki churna* 1gm HS with luke warm water.

L/A: Kanak ksheeri oil for local application.

#### Result after 1st month of treatment

There was a significant relief in patient in all symptoms.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Treatment plan (after 1month of medication) Before food

1) Ashthmurti rasayan -250 mg + Gandhak Rasayan -500mg + Rasa Manikya 125 mg + Panchnimba churna 1gm + Trivang Bhasma 125 mg + Godanti Bhamsa 500 mg BD with water.

**After Food:** 2) *Haridra Khanda* 1Tsf with *Panchtikta ghrita* 10 ml BD

*Triphla churna* 5gm + *Kutaki churna* 1gm HS with luke warm water.

L/A: Kanak ksheeri oil for local application.

After two months of treatments Now Patient is completely cure and not taking any medication for the scalp psoriasis. Patient is so happy and living a healthy life.

Ashtmurti Rasayana has Jantughna, Rakta Shodhak properties, it works on balancing of Vata, Pitta and Rakta, Mamsa, Meda Dhatu, Gandhak Rasavan is a classical drug, is blood purifier, It has antioxidant, digestive stimulant (mild effects), anti-inflammatory properties. It is a broad-spectrum antibiotic. Rasa Manikya works on Twak roga (skin disorders) and diseases due to aggravated Vata and Kapha doshas. Panch Nimba Churna detoxifies the body, increases hemoglobin level, balances Kapha, improves blood circulation and has anti-inflammatory properties. Trivang Bhasma has androgenic and aphrodisiac action. It balances Vata and Pitta, antidiabetic. Godanti Bhasma balances Pitta dosha and provides cooling effect in the body. It also has anti-inflammatory property. Haridra Khanda is

Anti allergic. It is used in Itching skin disorders, Fungal skin disorders and *Sheeta pitta*. *Panchatikta Ghrita* is *Shothahara* (anti-inflammatory), it gives relief from itching and irritation of skin, it also has *Pitta* balancing and *Shodhan* (detoxification) properties. *Triphla* powder is anti-inflammatory agent, antioxidant, it has anti-cancer properties. *Kutaki* powder has *Bhedana*, antioxidant and hepatoprotective. *Kanak ksheeri oil* impairs Keratinocytes, interferes in co-stimulatory molecules communications, it also helps to prevent silvery scaly lesions.
